RE: 2019 Landfill/Household Hazardous Waste Changes

Greetings:

As you may be aware, many changes occurred at the Renville County Landfill in 2018. Below are a list of changes for 2019 that may affect your business and its disposal needs:

1. The Renville County Demolition Landfill Hours have changed from Monday-Friday (8 AM – 4 PM) to Monday and Friday (8 AM – 4PM) Thursday (12 PM - 4 PM)
2. The Renville County MSW/Demolition Landfill stopped accepting residential/commercial Municipal Solid Waste (MSW/Garbage) as of November 1, 2018. Small amounts of “local” garbage continued until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018, at which time the final interim cover was placed with the cell closure.
3. The Renville County Demolition Landfill will ONLY be accepting CLEAN demolition waste at the county landfill. (See attached list of acceptable material or view the Renville County Webpage).
4. Stumps, tree and brush material will NO LONGER be accepted at the landfill. Please check with the local city or township for an alternate disposal location.
5. Appliances/Electronics (of any kind) will NO LONGER be accepted, but can be taken to the one of many county sponsored monthly collections at the Renville County Fair Grounds. These collection are from 2-6 p.m., and are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month April – October. For more information visit the Renville County web page (RRRSWA Link).
6. Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Small amounts of new/used: paint, stains, varnishes, fuels, motor oil, batteries (button, alkaline, rechargeable), bulbs (fluorescent/LED/HPS/etc., household cleaning products.
7. Business Waste will NO LONGER be accepted for FREE at the county landfill. Items such as Bulbs (fluorescent, mercury vapor, LED, etc.,) ballasts (PBC/Non PBC), etc., will be charged accordingly. If you generate a large quantity of bulbs, we can supply you a barrel (4’ or 8’) to be filled and delivered back to the landfill by you or your staff. The landfill will then invoice your business with a reduced price under the State contracted price structure, or we can provide you with a list of companies who can collect and transport your bulbs.
8. Mattresses (clean) will NO LONGER be recycled at the county landfill, but can be recycled at the Redwood/Renville Regional Material Recovery and Transfer Facility in Redwood Falls.
9. Used Tires WILL CONTINUE to be accepted at a reduced rate, but will now be charged either per tire and/or per ton basis (depending on the number).
10. Scrap Metal WILL CONTINUE to be accepted.
11. Recyclable Materials WILL CONTINUE to be accepted.
